ORDER

This matter is before the Court on the *Urgent Motion of the Bank of New York Mellon, as Trustee, to Expedite Consideration of its Urgent Motion for Leave to Intervene in the Commonwealth-COFINA Dispute for a Limited Purpose* (Dkt. No. 505) (the “Motion to Expedite”). Therein, the Bank of New York Mellon (“BNYM”) seeks to expedite briefing on and consideration of its Motion to Intervene (Dkt. No. 503). Given that BNYM seeks to intervene for the purpose of commenting on an urgent motion in this adversary proceeding (Dkt. No. 495), which itself is on an expedited schedule, good cause exists for the Motion to Expedite. Accordingly, the Motion to Expedite is ALLOWED and the briefing deadlines for the Motion to Intervene shall be as follows:

1. Any objections to the Motion to Intervene shall be filed by **June 25, 2018**.
2. Any reply shall be filed by **June 27, 2018**.
3. The Court will thereafter take the Motion to Intervene on submission.
